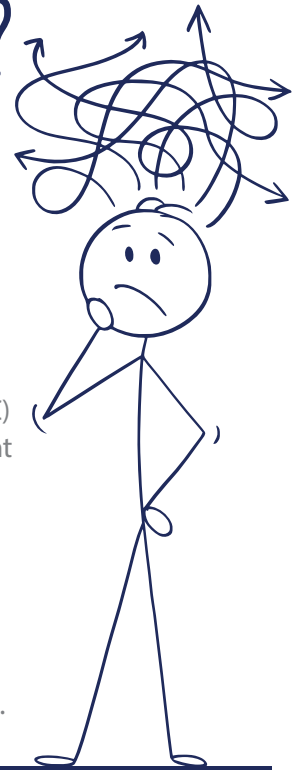


# CAN'T FIND YOUR CLASSES FOR FALL 2026?

## IT COULD BE COMMON COURSE CONFUSION.



### WHAT IS COMMON COURSE NUMBERING?

- California Community Colleges have made it easier for students to transfer credits between schools by using a new system called the Common Course Numbering (CCN). The CCN system gives the same subject prefixes, course numbers and titles to similar classes at all community colleges in California.
- Common Course Numbering also makes transferring to universities like the University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU) more straightforward. It ensures that course numbering is consistent across colleges, helping students navigate their academic path with confidence.

### IMPLEMENTING COMMON COURSE NUMBERING

- Starting in Fall 2025, MJC implemented the new course numbering system. The courses listed as "old course" in the crosswalk table below are now assigned the "new course" CCN numbers.
- Students should use the crosswalk below or MJC Class Search to look up new CCN course numbers.
